



The network is still growing e.g. new sites in Malta and several UK sites in preparation




Conservation status of marine habitats per biogeographic region as reported under the Habitats Directive





Similar for species






Proportion of Marine Natura 2000 sites with conservation measures and management plans

Conclusions

- The Natura 2000 network including parts of the marine territory of 23 countries and covering more than 4% of Europe's seas can be considered a success
- Some elements still need work: more equitable implementation across Europe's seas, increased focus on representativity and coherence and a stronger evaluation of the effectiveness of management measures in place.
- Important differences between regional seas
- Better information is required
- A holistic approach bringing together the Nature Directives, the MSFD, the WFD and the CFP and working with the marine conventions and others is required
