coverage


- the coasts, territorial and jurisdictional waters

ecosystem approach


• Directive 2014/89/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 23 July 2014 established a framework for maritime spatial planning






carbon footprin

- blueprint for Sectoral Cooperation










prospects
