

Provence-Alpes-Côte d'Azur Region committed to « Une Cop d'avance »



- Main action « Zero plastic waste to landfills by 2030 » reaffirmed and enhanced by:
 - Regional Climate Plan approved in December 2017 by the regional parliament (100 actions, 373 M€ of budget for 2018, with possibility of increase up to 560M€/year)
 - Regional Plan for Waste Prevention and Management (PRPGD), in line with EU **Directive Waste Management Plans**





«Zero plastic waste to landfills by 2030 » promoted by 91% of the regional population

(IFOP survey, january 2018)

« Zero Plastic waste to landfills by 2030 », a program with 22 actions deliberated in June 2016

- Circular Economy component supported by the regional regulatory tools:
- Environmental component supported by public policies relating to:

- Regional plan for waste prevention and management (PRPGD),
- Economy, training and employment strategies.

- The Mediterranean,
- Biodiversity,
- The elimination of plastic pollution of natural environments and the sea through preventive and corrective means.

Decrease the use of raw materials

Supporting recycling process and innovation, especially on composites

Plastics value contributes to decreasing leaks in the environment





Circular Economy Component of « Zero plastic waste to landfills by 2030 »

- Regional regulatory lever:
 - The future Regional Plan for Waste Prevention and Management provides for:
 - Prohibition of plastic packagings to landfill by 2025
 - Prohibition of all plastics to landfill by 2030

Strong expectations on the activation of the European and national regulatory levers

- Improve knowledge and bring together the links in the plastics value chain
- Steering committee (Technical committee)
- Study on characterization waste deposits and existing recycling processes
- Study on plasturgy innovations

 - Design and plastic, Regional design contest « Hello Goodbye »
 - Sociological study on behaviour change
 - High school Spring challenge
 - Exemplary community

Transverse restraint: new markets, complex quantification of deposits

Actions
to short and
medium terms

- Creation of additional massification points
- Support dismantling and sorting activities for better separation of materials (evolution of existing points, creation of new sites, R&D)
- Evaluation of the opportunity to create a valorization unit for fiberglass composites
- Stimulation of the demand of recycled materials from composites via public procurement


