

Building an efficient interdisciplinary scientific community for Policy Relevant Knowledge Workshop MSP 20 March 2015 - recommendations;


- Tool; Create a long-term knowledge hub

Possible next steps:

- Develop the needed scientific knowledge base and scientific methodological advice to support coherent long-term views and visions with optimal co-use of uses of the sea;
- **Build human capacity** by identifying the skills gaps and informing educational initiatives
- **Possible joint call for research** (timing beyond 2017?) possible engaging structural funds
