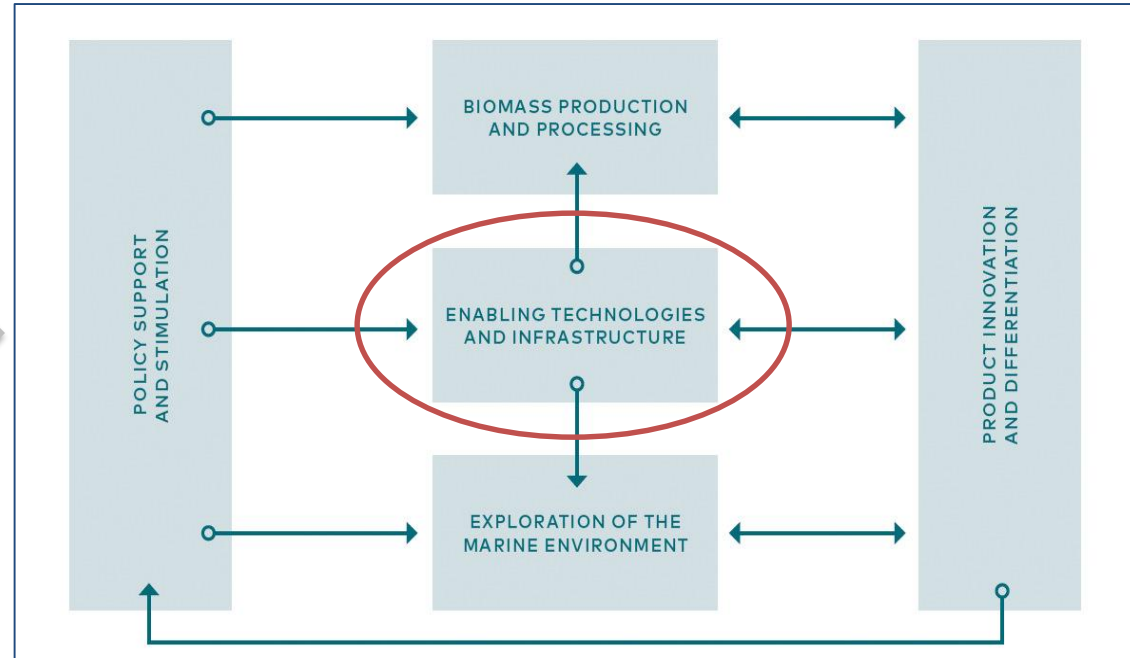
Results of ERA-NET MarineBiotech

- **Launched three calls for proposals and two joint calls**
 - 3 calls €20m supported 15 projects ~ 60 researchers in 14 countries
 - 2 joint calls – IndBio and Cofasp
- **Engaged with multiple stakeholders to establish industry-science and industry-policy interactions**
- **Completed a “foresight” exercise**
- **Delivered a Strategic Research and Innovation Roadmap**
- **Outreach activity – 7 newsletters, 27 reports 25 presentations**
- **Created a network to support marine biotechnology**
 - ERA-NET Cofund on Blue Bioeconomy (BlueBio) - *Unlocking the Potential of Aquatic Bioresources* (BG-02-2018) 2018-23
 - 29 partners from 16 countries - €31.85 million for research call
